


Figure 1. Model H7725 Birch Workbench.

Safety & Limitations

- Maximum workbench table load is 500 lbs.
- Do not stand or climb on the workbench.
- Do not apply an unbalanced load on the table that could result in the workbench tipping over.
- Keep unsupervised children away from the workbench.
- Do not stand or climb on the workbench.
- Do not use workbench outdoors or in wet or damp locations.
- Do not overload the vises or use cheater pipes on the vise handles to increase leverage.
- Do not weld on this bench.

Assembly

Refer to the last page of these instructions to inventory your shipment for ease of assembly.

To assemble the workbench:




Figure 2. Tilt-drawer assembly.

 Insert eight (E5) barrel nuts into panels (LF & LB), and assemble the drawer with eight (E1) screws in the orientation shown in Figure 2.




Figure 3. Right leg and cross brace installation.

 Position the right side leg (B) on the floor so the FRONT arrow points to the front and install two barrel nuts (E4) into cross brace (D & E) as shown in Figure 3.

- 3. Insert the two lower cross braces (D & E) into the slots in the right leg (B).
- 4. Use a 5mm hex wrench to secure the cross braces to the leg with two (E2) flat washers and two (E3) barrel bolts, but do not fully tighten at this time.




Figure 4. Lower panel installation.

- 5. Slide the lower panel (F) into the slots of the two cross braces, and then into the slot in the right leg (B) (**Figure 4**).




Figure 5. Left leg installation.

- 6. Position the left side leg (C) on the floor and install the remaining (E4) barrel nuts into cross braces (D, E, & I) (**Figure 5**), and install cross brace (I) into the right leg.
- 7. Connect the left leg to cross braces (D, E, & I), and use a 5mm hex wrench to secure the braces to the leg with three (E2) flat washers, and three (E3) barrel bolts, but do not fully tighten at this time.




Figure 6. Tilt-drawer installation.

8. Invert the tilt-drawer and install it between the left and right legs as shown in **Figure 6** with the (E9) screws, (E2) flat washers, and the (H2) brass tube.

Note: To prevent the sides of the tilt-drawer from rubbing on the legs of the workbench when opened and closed, do not tighten the (E9) screw completely. Stop tightening it when the drawer side and leg have approximately 3mm of clearance between each other.




Figure 7. Final cross support installation.

9. With the tilt-drawer in position as shown in Figure 6, install two (E4) barrel nuts in the remaining cross support (H), and secure it in place (Figure 7) between the legs with the remaining (E3) screws and (E2) washers.

- **10.** At this time tighten all of the (E3) barrel bolts except the (E9) barrel bolts used as the tilting-drawer hinge pins.
- 11. With the help of an assistant, return the workbench to the upright position, and lower the table top (A) onto the legs making sure to line up the pre-drilled holes in the legs and the underside of the workbench.
- **12.** Working from the underside of the table legs, insert four (E8) screws and (E2) washers into the holes, and use the 4mm hex wrench to tighten the screws.




Figure 8. Table vise installation.

- 13. Insert the guide rods and leadscrew through the holes in the wood block (G) (Figure 8). Thread the leadscrew into the vise support until the wood block is slightly snug against the table and flush with the table top.

- **14.** Keeping the wood block flush with the table top (**Figure 8**), drill two ⁵/₆" holes 1⁷/₁₆" deep through the vise plate mounting holes and into the wood block.
- **15.** Secure the vise plate to the wood block with two (H1) #5 x 1⁷/₁₆" wood screws (**Figure 8**).
- **16.** Under the table, place a cotter pin in the end of the leadscrew, bending only one cotter pin leg to a 90 degree angle.




Figure 9. Tail vise installation.

17. Insert the tail vise wood block into the vise support block (Figure 9). Insert the tail vise leadscrew through the holes in the wood block and the vise support block at the edge of the table.

- 18. Turn the tail vise handle clockwise until the wood block just touches the table, and attach the vise plate as outlined in Steps 15 & 16.





Figure 10. Gas spring installation.

- **19.** Find the gas spring pins at the drawer underside, and install the gas springs (H5) with the two (H6) screws for each spring (**Figure 10**).
