Introduction


The Model T33913 Multi-Function Roller Stand incorporates a flat top table, cylindrical roller support, roller ball support, and V-roller support to accommodate a wide variety of workpiece shapes and sizes.

- · Use roller stand on flat surface.
- Secure stand adjustments with indexing clip, holding clips, and height lock levers before using.
- DO NOT stand or climb on any part of stand.




Figure 2. Main inventory.




Figure 3. Fasteners.

Assembly



The Model T33913 must be fully assembled before it can be used. Before beginning the assembly process, refer to **Needed for Setup** and gather all listed items.

To assemble stand:




Figure 4. Plastic feet installed.

1. Slide (4) plastic feet onto bottoms of stand legs (see **Figure 4**).




Figure 5. Braces secured to stand leg.

2. Slide (2) leg braces over (1) stand leg, with threaded hole facing away from braces (see Figure 5), and secure with (4) M6-1 x 37 Phillips head screws, 6mm flat washers, and M6-1 hex nuts.




Figure 6. Second stand leg secured to braces.

3. Slide second stand leg into opposite ends of braces and secure with (4) M6-1 x 37 Phillips head screws, 6mm flat washers, and M6-1 hex nuts (see **Figure 6**).




Figure 7. Extension bars (1 of 2) attached to multi-function head.

- **4.** Attach (2) extension bars to multi-function head with (4) M8-1.25 x 40 hex bolts, (8) 8mm flat washers, and (4) M8-1.25 lock nuts (see **Figure 7**).
- Pull indexing clip on multi-function head and rotate head so attachment posts are facing upward (see Figure 7).




Figure 8. Location of spring button.

6. Slide removable flat top over attachment posts (see Figure 8) and press spring buttons to allow table to slide down and lock in place.

- 7. Slide extension bars into stand legs (see Figure 9).
- 8. Adjust head to required height, ensuring extension bar and stand locking holes are aligned. Insert holding clips through holes to secure, with clip handles facing inward (as shown in **Figure 9**).




Figure 10. Height locking levers installed.

9. Thread height lock levers into stand leg threaded holes, then tighten to secure stand in place (see **Figure 10**).

Rotating Multi-Function Head




Figure 12. Flat roller in use.

The multi-function head can be easily rotated to the desired support setting to match the needs of the project (see **Figures 12–15**).

To rotate multi-function head:

- 1. Remove all projects from roller stand.




Figure 15. Location of indexing clip.

- Pull indexing clip outward and rotate multifunction head to desired position, then release indexing clip to lock in place (see Figure 15).

Note: To use V-roller, removable flat top must be removed.

Fixing Multi-Function Head Position




Figure 16. Multi-function head secured with fasteners.

The multi-function head can be secured in place with the included M8-1.25 x 16 hex bolt, two 8mm flat washers, and M8-1.25 hex nut (see **Figure 16**) to prevent the head from moving when working with heavier workpieces or long-term projects.

Adjusting V-Rollers




Figure 17. Location of spring bolts.

The V-rollers can be positioned to accommodate various sizes of round workpieces. To adjust, simply press spring bolt down (see **Figure 17**), adjust roller to desired position, then release the spring bolt.
